Documents to be submitted six weeks before the wedding.

- 1) Letter from Bride's father/Mother addressed to the Bishop in Madras seeking permission to have the wedding in the Cathedral.
- 2) Letter from the Bride's Pastor addressed to the Bishop in Madras seeking permission to have the wedding in the Cathedral.
- 3) Certificate before Banns from Bride's Church.
- 4) Letter from Bridegroom's father/Mother addressed to the Bishop in Madras seeking permission to have the wedding in the Cathedral.
- 5) Letter from the Bridegroom's Pastor addressed to the Bishop in Madras seeking permission to have the wedding in the Cathedral.
- 6) Certificate before Banns from Bridegroom's Church.
- 7) A Certification from a Notary from Groom's place of residence (for all non Indian nationals and for Indian Nationals residing abroad for more than two years).
- 8) A Certification from a Notary from Bride's place of residence (for all non Indian nationals and for Indian Nationals residing abroad for more than two years).
- 9) When the party is from another denomination which is in full communion with the CSI, or from another Diocese of the CSI then they should provide a request letter from their Bishop addressed to the CSI Bishop in Madras.
- 10) Rs.1000/- fees to be paid to the Madras Diocese for Third Party Permission
